1. Welcome and Introductions

This is an application for a new On-licence by <u>Multiplex Cinemas Limited</u> in relation to the premises known as "Embassy 3 Cinema". The applicant wishes to add the sale of alcoholic refreshments for eligible patrons for consumption within the complex as part of the cinema experience.

The application was publically notified in accordance with s. 101 of the Act.

The application attracted one objection within the prescribed statutory timeframe. The objection was received from Safer Whanganui Alcohol and Other Drug Reference Group who have objected on grounds of object of the Act, proposed days and hours of sale, design and layout and systems and staff.

All three statutory reports from the reporting agencies offered no opposition to the application i.e. Medical Officer of Health, Police and Inspector.

The Whanganui District Licensing issued a Direction Notice on the 1 June 2022 and another on the 9 June 2022, assessing the objector as meeting s. 102(1)(2) and (3) status requirements.

The matter was subsequently set down for hearing.
