## **1. Welcome and Introductions**

This is an application for a new On-licence by Lads Brewing Company Limited in relation to the premises known as “Lads Brewing Company”. The applicant wishes to obtain a Tavern Style On-licence at a premise they have used previously for special licensed events and brewing.

The application was publically notified in accordance with s. 101 of the Act.

The application attracted one public objection (Ref. “B”) within the prescribed statutory timeframe. The objection was received from Mr Geoff and Mrs Genevieve Lott who reside at 10 Taylor Street, Whanganui. They objected on grounds of ‘amenity and good order’, specifically proximity, parking, noise, amenity, litter and disorder.

Both the Inspector and Police enquired into the application and furnished s.103 reports in opposition (Ref. “C” and “D”). The Medical Officer of Health furnished a report of no opposition (Ref. “E”).

The Whanganui District Licensing Committee issued a Direction Notice (Ref. “F”) on the 7 July 2022 assessing the objector as meeting s. 102(1) (2) and (3) status requirements, setting the matter down for hearing and summoning appropriate Council Officers to assist the hearing.
