the fover of Community House on Ridgway Street is open during the election period from 10.00am until 2.00pm weekdays. The centre is available for people to find out more about standing and voting in the upcoming local elections.

Council staff member and one of the faces of the council's election campaign, Christina Emery, says the purpose of being out and about in the community is to make sure information is as accessible as possible, especially to those who might not have participated in an election before.

"People are welcome to come and chat about what's involved in the elections process, find out about standing for council or just to check they are correctly enrolled."

#### **LOCAL ELECTION KEY DATES**

- August 12, at 12 noon Candidate nominations close
- August 17 The full list of candidates standing in the election will be announced
- September 16 Voting papers will be sent out to enrolled voters between this date and September 21
- October 8, at 12 noon Voting closes and initial results will be published later in the day. Final results will be available between this date and October 13.
