RESERVED DECISION OF THE DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Alisha-Jane Takarangi made the application on the prescribed form received on the 26th April 2018. The applicant intends to use the certificate at Station United Sports Club (Club-licence), where the applicant has worked for over three years.

The application included one character reference from her employer, attesting to experience in the industry and suitability, along with other character references and qualifications. Alisha-Jane did obtain a managers certificate in 2017 but has let it lapse.

The applicant has attained the relevant License Controller Qualification and has no declared convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- *(a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- *(b) any convictions recorded against the applicant:*

- *(c)any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*
- *(d)any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- *(e)any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No report within statutory timeframe therefore assume no opposition to the application.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing Alisha-Jane Takarangi's credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector has interviewed the applicant and is satisfied that the applicant has the necessary knowledge to hold the certificate.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete and records no opposition to the granting of the application.

4 Conclusion


Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that Alisha-Jane Takarangi meets the criteria to be granted a Managers Certificate in accordance with the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application for manager's certificate is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year.
