RESERVED DECISION OF THE DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Alisha-Jane Takarangi made the application on the prescribed form received on 24th March 2017. The applicant has experience working at the Station United Sports since 2015 where she intends using the certificate.

The application included the applicant's qualifications and a letter from the Station United Sports Manager attesting to the applicants experience and suitability to manage the licence.

The applicant has attained the relevant License Controller Qualification. The applicant has three convictions, none of which are alcohol related. Both the Police and Inspector have not raised this as an issue.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- *(a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- *(b) any convictions recorded against the applicant:*

- *(c)any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*
- *(d)any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#):*
- *(e)any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).*

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition noted within report received 27 March 2017.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing Alisha-Jane Takarangi credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector has interviewed the applicant and is satisfied that the applicant has the necessary knowledge and experience to hold the certificate.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete and appears to meet the criteria under s.222 of the Act.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that Alisha-Jane Takarangi meets the criteria to be granted a Managers Certificate in accordance with the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application for manager's certificate is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year.
