DECISION

1. Introduction

This is an application by **G K McIvor Trading Limited** for Temporary Authority (second) in respect of the premises situated at 77 Moana Street, Wanganui and currently known as 'Eastbrook Four Square'.

The application comes about from a change of ownership and is required to allow the applicant to continue trading while the application for a new licence is processed by the Licensing Committee. This is the second Temporary Authority made by the applicant against the licence. The applicant has a substantive off-licence applied for however it has still to be fully processed and determined.

2. Application

The application is made against off-licence **036/OFF/002/2019** which has an expiry date of 27 March 2023.

The application was not advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received under section 103 of the Act. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers in accordance with sections 136 and 202(1) of the Act.

In considering the application for temporary authority the committee had regard to the object of the Act and reports furnished by Police and Inspector.

3. Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under the Act.

Police Report – No opposition.

Licensing Inspector Report – The inspector notes that the applicant is an incorporated private company with two directors/shareholders. The applicant took possession on the 31 October 2022 and has supplied relevant documents with the application.

The Inspector notes the first Temporary Authority lapses on the 31 January 2023.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete and meets the criteria of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The inspector recommends that the licence be issued subject to conditions.

I concur with the inspector's assessment and conditions.

4. Decision

Accordingly the application for Temporary Licence is **Approved,** valid for 3 months from the date of issue or when the Substantive Licence Application lodged by the applicant is determined, whichever is the sooner.

The Temporary Authority can be issued immediately, to take affect from 1 February 2023, with the conditions recommended in the inspectors report.
