DECISION

1. Introduction

This is an application by **Gagan & Vikaus Enterprises Limited** for Temporary Authority (first) in respect of the premises situated at 99a Guyton Street, Wanganui and currently known as 'The Grand Hotel'.

The application comes about from a change of ownership and is required to allow the applicant to continue trading while the application for a new licence is processed by the Licensing Committee. This is the first Temporary Authority made by the applicant against the licence. The applicant has a substantive On-licence applied for that will take time to be processed and determined.

2. Application

The application is made against On-licence **036/ON/001/2022** which has an expiry date of 23 May 2023.

The application was not advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received under section 103 of the Act. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers in accordance with sections 136 and 202(1) of the Act.

In considering the application for temporary authority the committee had regard to the object of the Act and reports furnished by Police and Inspector.

3. Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under the Act.

Police Report – No opposition within report dated 10 January 2023.

Licensing Inspector Report – The inspector notes that the applicant is an incorporated private company with one director and two shareholders. The applicant takes possession on the 15 February 2023 and has supplied relevant documents with the application.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete and meets the criteria of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The inspector recommends that the licence be issued subject to conditions.


I concur with the inspector's assessment and conditions.

4. Decision

Accordingly the application for Temporary Licence is **Approved**, valid for 3 months from the date it takes effect from or when the Substantive Licence Application lodged by the applicant is determined, whichever is the sooner.

The Temporary Authority can be issued immediately, to take affect from 15 February 2023, with the conditions recommended in the inspectors report.
