DECISION OF THE WHANGANUI DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Gareth Jones made the application on the prescribed form received 27 August 2025. The applicant has experience using the certificate at Pak n Save. The applicant has the required qualifications and has not incurred any relevant convictions since last renewal.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 227 of the Act.

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Gareth Jones** meets the criteria to have the Managers Certificate renewed in terms with section 227 of the Act for three years.
