DECISION

1. Introduction

This is an application by Naki Illuminati Limited for Temporary Authority in respect of the premises situated at 143-145 Anzac Parade, Wanganui and currently known as 'Anndion Lodge and Function Centre'.

The application comes about from a change of ownership and is required to allow the applicant to continue trading while the application for a new licence is processed by the Licensing Committee. This is the <u>second</u> Temporary Authority made by the applicant against the licence.

2. Application

The application is made against on-licence **036/ON/009/2013** which has an expiry date of 23rd December, 2016, although this licence has been applied to be renewed under **036/ON/014/2016**.

The application was not advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received under section 103 of the Act. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers in accordance with sections 136 and 202(1) of the Act.

In considering the application for temporary authority the committee had regard to the object of the Act and reports furnished by Police and Inspector.

3. Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under the Act.

Police Report – No objection within report received on 11th May 2017.

Licensing Inspector Report — The inspector notes that the applicant is an incorporated private company with two directors and shareholders. The applicant took possession on the 1st February 2017 and has supplied relevant documents with the application.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete and meets the criteria of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The inspector recommends that the licence be issued subject to conditions.

I concur with the inspector's assessment and conditions.

4. Decision

Accordingly the application for Temporary Licence is **Approved**, valid for 3 months from this issue date <u>(23rd May 2017)</u> or when the Substantive Licence Application lodged by the applicant is determined, whichever is the sooner.

The Temporary Authority can be issued with the conditions recommended in the inspectors report.
