**DECISION OF THE WHANGANUI DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE**

**1. Application**

**Richard Lisle** made the application on the prescribed form received 10 February 2025. The applicant has experience using the certificate at Castlecliff Club (Charter Style Club-licence). The applicant has the required qualifications and has not incurred any relevant convictions since last renewal.

**2. Decision Making**

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 227 of the Act.

*(a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*

*(b) any convictions recorded against the applicant since the certificate was issued or last renewed:*

*(c) the manner in which the manager has managed the sale and supply of alcohol pursuant to the licence with the aim of contributing to the reduction of alcohol-related harm:*

*(d) any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 225](#).*

**3 Reporting Agencies**

The following reports were received under section 225 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

**3.1 Police** – No opposition within report dated 18 February 2025.

**3.2 Licensing Inspector** – Full report including opinion that **Richard Lisle** has managed the certificate in accordance with the requirements under the Act and license conditions. The Inspector further recommends removing the current undertaking on the certificate. This is supported.

**4 Conclusion**

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that **Richard Lisle** meets the criteria to have the Managers Certificate renewed in terms with section 227 of the Act for three years.

**5 Decision**

Accordingly, the application for renewal is **Approved** for issue immediately for a period of 3 years dated from the expiry of the current certificate, together with the undertaking being removed.
