**DECISION**

**1. Introduction**

This is an application by **Shepherds Pantry Limited** for Temporary Authority in respect of the premises situated at 77 Moana Street, Wanganui and currently known as 'Eastbrook Four Square'.

The application comes about from a change of ownership and is required to allow the applicant to continue trading while the application for a new licence is processed by the Licensing Committee. This is the first Temporary Authority made by the applicant against the licence.

**2. Application**

The application is made against off-licence **036/OFF/001/2023** which has an expiry date of 8 March 2027.

The application was not advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received under section 103 of the Act. Accordingly we deal with the matter on the papers in accordance with sections 136 and 202(1) of the Act.

In considering the application for temporary authority the committee had regard to the object of the Act and reports furnished by Police and Inspector.

**3. Reporting Agencies**

The following reports were received under the Act.

**Police Report** – No report within report dated 16 October 2022.

**Licensing Inspector Report** – The inspector notes that the applicant is an incorporated private company incorporated on the 16 September 2024. The applicant takes possession on the 11 November 2024 and has supplied relevant documents with the application.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete and meets the criteria of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. The inspector recommends that the licence be issued subject to conditions.

I concur with the inspector's assessment and conditions.

**4. Decision**

Accordingly the application for Temporary Licence is **Approved**, valid for 3 months from the 11 November 2024 or when the Substantive Licence Application lodged by the applicant is determined, whichever is the sooner.

The Temporary Authority can be issued immediately, to take affect from 11 November 2024, with the conditions recommended in the inspectors report.
