The application included evidence of obtaining the necessary License Controller Qualification and a letter from her employer attesting to applicants experience and skills. The applicant has not incurred any convictions.

2. Decision Making

- **3.2 Licensing Inspector** Full report assessing Toni Lynne Ericsson's credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector has interviewed the applicant and concludes that the application is complete and appears to meet the criteria of section 222 of the Act. The Inspector's report offers no opposition.

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that Toni Lynne Ericsson meets the criteria to hold a Managers Certificate under the Act.
