RESERVED DECISION OF THE DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. Application

Paras Rawat made the application on the prescribed form received on the 13th April 2017. The applicant intends to use the certificate at Tasty Indian Restaurant (On-licence Restaurant) Whanganui. The applicant has experience at the Tasty Indian Restaurant and Cracked Pepper Restaurant.

The application included the applicant's qualifications and two letters from previous employees attesting to the applicants experience and suitability to manage the licence.

The applicant has attained the relevant License Controller Qualification and has not incurred any convictions.

2. Decision Making

In considering this application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee had regard to the following criteria under section 222 of the Act.

- *(a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:*
- *(b) any convictions recorded against the applicant:*
- *(c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:*

- (d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under [section 218](#);
- (e) any matters dealt with in any report made under [section 220](#).

3 Reporting Agencies

The following reports were received under section 220 of the Act and taken into account during the decision.

3.1 Police – No opposition noted with report received 11 May 2017.

3.2 Licensing Inspector – Full report assessing Paras Rawat credentials against the Acts criteria. The inspector has interviewed the applicant and is satisfied that the applicant has the necessary knowledge and experience to hold the certificate.

The inspector concludes that the application is complete and records no opposition to the granting of the application.

4 Conclusion

Based on the evidence provided to me within the application and statutory reports I conclude that Paras Rawat meets the criteria to be granted a Managers Certificate in accordance with the Act.

5 Decision

Accordingly the application for manager's certificate is **Approved** for issue for a period of one year.
