Wholeheartedly agree with the retention and amending of the Alcohol Control Bylaw as per the recommendations. The review information and the reports from the Police indicate the Bylaw is working as intended: reducing higher levels of offending and allowing for graduated responses by the Police which free up their resources for more urgent activity as well as enabling people in public spaces to be educated and avoid more intensive involvement with the justice system.

As a general statement we agree that the amendment increases the clarity and usability of the bylaw.

Changing the definitions to reference the definitions in the SASA 2012 legislation is a sensible move. Not only does it achieve further clarity and potentially restrict challenges around legal definitions - but it also future-proofs the Bylaw should the legislation change.

Similarly, referring undefined words to their meaning in the Act may avoid problems in the same way.

Temporary Control Areas: – this seems an appropriate, measured and reasonable provision. The empowering section contains a fairly extensive list of factors to consider before instituting a temporary ban which should ensure they are imposed with due deliberation.

With reference to specific drafting matters we would suggest the "his or her" phrase in s.8(1)(c) be replaced with "theirs" unless your drafters have a specific reason for that construction.
