This map shows the area traditionally occupied by Ngā Rauru, stretching between the Whanganui and Pātea rivers. The Ngā Rauru Kīitahi claims have been settled to the northern side of Kai Iwi Stream only.

The Whanganui area is currently under Te Atihaunui a paparangi claims by Te Runanga o Tupoho and Te Runanga o Tamaupoko. Te Runanga o Tupoho is mandated Iwi authority for the Southern side of Kai Iwi Stream to the Northern side of the Whangaehu River.

There is an agreement between Whanganui and Ngarauru Iwi E Whanganui Ai E Rauru Ai E Rua Ai, we have an agreement that mana Whenua from Whanganui to Kaiiwi shall be Whanganui Iwi who recognise that Ngarauru Iwi have mana in places that hold cultural significance and both Whanganui and Ngarauru will make decisions that are beneficial. This responsibility has been left with Te Runanga O Tupoho on behalf of Whanganui Iwi. It has been noted in the past that an Accord between Ngarauru Iwi and Whanganui District Council would be formed, until then that all points of contact would be through Ngarauru Iwi administration.

Recently the Ngarauru Authorities have granted rights to Tamareheroto from the Kai iwi Hapu group who claim whananganuitanaga with Whanganui Iwi which has been recognised by Te Runanga O Tupoho
