WANGANUI DISTRICT PLAN REVIEW - DESIGNATION ROLL OVERS

Thanks you for your letter 22 May 2012 regarding the review of the Wanganui District Plan ('Plan').

Pursuant to Clause 4 of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991, Transpower New Zealand Limited gives notice to roll over two (2) designations in Wanganui District Plan. These designations can be rolled over without modification. A minor correction is required to each designation, and the designation description has been clarified (as requested).

Current descriptions of the designation in the District Plan

Included below are the current descriptions of the two (2) designations we wish to roll over as part of your review process.

Transpower (Requiring Authority) Name: Wanganui Substation

Designation Number: D46

Purpose of Designation: Substation Location: 401 No 2 Line, Wanganui Legal Description: Sec 1 SO 18038

Area: 2.0899ha Planning Map: R19 Underlying Zone: Rural

And;

Transpower (Requiring Authority) Name: Brunswick Substation

Designation Number: D47

Purpose of Designation: Substation Location: 542 Brunswick Road Legal Description: Pt Lot 1 A 2040

Area: 5.2862ha Planning Map: R18 Underlying Zone: Rural

The two (2) designations have no conditions included.

Clarifications / Minor Corrections

The existing designations are for the purpose of 'Electricity'. However as requested by Wanganui District Council, we have included a clearer statement of purpose below. This clearer statement reflects the activities that are carried out at the substation sites.

Transpower requests the following to be included in the Wanganui District Plan Review:

- a) Confirms that both the Wanganui and Brunswick Substations be <u>retained</u> in the revised 'Plan'.
- Revised description of the purpose for the two (2) designations to read –
 'Substation Electricity Transmission and Telecommunications networks'.
- c) Nature of modifications none required.
- d) Three (3) minor corrections are needed as follows:

Wanganui Substation

- Correct the area shown in the district plan to 2.1246ha refer attached Computer Freehold Register with diagram 33B/961
- ii. Correct the extent of the designation shown in the District Planning Map to cover the full area of the property (Section 1 Survey Office Plan 18038) – refer attached map titled 'Wanganui Substation Designation Area'.

The entire property as shown on the attached Computer Freehold Register is subject to the designation. However, it appears to have been incorrectly recorded in the District Plan.

Brunswick Substation

iii. Correct the area shown tin he district plan to 5.1821 – refer attached Computer Freehold Register with diagram 33B/876

Reason for the minor corrections

In previous District Plan rollovers Transpower has provided Wanganui District Council with the above information – e.g. letter from Transpower to Wanganui District Council, 23 January 1997, however this information has not been corrected in the District Plan. We request on this occasion the designated areas reflect the entire boundary area of each title, as per the attached Free Hold Registers. Noting this is a minor change to the extent of the designation and no environmental effects result as the activity is still contained within the boundaries of the titles.

The above minor corrections will ensure the District Plan is consistent with the information contained within the Computer Freehold Registers i.e. ensure the 'legal descriptions', 'area' are accurate. The correction of the designated area at Wanganui Substation will ensure the planning maps are a correct representation of the extent of the designated area. The designation shown in the District Plan Maps does not cover the whole property i.e. 2.1246ha. The current area of 2.0899ha shown in the District Plan is not a true reflection of the designation area shown in the planning maps.

These minor corrections are included in the tables (2x), as well as the enclosed plan entitled 'Wanganui Substation Designation Area'.

Transpower's requiring authority approvals

By way of background, I note that Transpower was approved by Order in Council on 19 May 1994 (refer attachment Gazette Notices) as a requiring authority and has authority to notify requirements for designations:

"...for its network operation of the supply of line function services".

Transpower was also approved by Order in Council on 29 September 1997 (refer attachment Gazette Notices) as a requiring authority with the authority for the development of telecommunication networks:

"...for the supply, operation, maintenance and development of a telecommunications network".





- (2) This notice shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its publication in the New Zealand Gazette.
- 2. Interpretation—In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires, "line function services" has the same meaning as in section 2 (1) of the Electricity Act 1992.
- 3. Approval as requiring authority—Trans Power New Zealand Limited is hereby approved as a requiring authority for its network operation of the supply of line function services.

Pursuant to section 167 of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Minister for the Environment hereby gives the following notice:

Notice

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Resource Management (Approval of Transpower New Zealand Limited as Requiring Authority) Notice 1997.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its publication in the New Zealand Gazette.
- 2. Interpretation—In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires, "telecommunications" has the meaning given to that term by section 2 (i) of the Telecommunications Act 1987.
- 3. Approval as requiring authority—Transpower New Lealand Limited is hereby approved as a requiring authority under section 167 of the Resource Management Act 1991, for the supply, operation, maintenance and development of a telecommunications network.
