

**Public Notice of Summary of Submissions and Call for Further Submissions to  
Proposed Plan Change 53 - Springvale Structure Plan to the Operative Whanganui  
District Plan**

*Clause 7, First Schedule, Resource Management Act*

Whanganui District Council has prepared a summary of submissions for the following proposed Plan Change **(PC53)** to the Whanganui District Plan:

**PC53 (Springvale Structure Plan)** proposes a framework for future residential development and identifies additional residential zoned land and key infrastructure required. PC53 is intended to meet projected residential demand in Springvale for the next 50 years.

A person who makes a further submission must also serve a copy of it on the person who made the submission to which the further submission relates, not later than 5 working days after the day on which the person provides the further submission to Council
