

FACT SHEET - Utility Connections

What is a Utility Connection?

A Utility connection is a connection to the Council's Urban or Rural

- Sewer (Waste Water) Network
- Water Network
- Storm water Network: (Direct Connection to Pipeline or Outlet to the Kerb)

Urban Utilities

How do I arrange an Urban Utility Connection?

You must arrange an Urban Utility Connection directly with an Approved Contractor. See *Approved Utility Connection Contractor Register (AUCC)* for a list

What is an Approved Contractor?

An Approved Contractor is a Contractor who has Council Approval to provide Utility Connections.

What is the Process?

 Home Owner to Obtain a Quote from the Approved Contractor

(Payment direct to Contractor)

2. The Approved Contractor will apply for a Utility Connection on your behalf

3. The Utility Connection is Installed

Rural Utilities

How can I arrange a Rural Utility Connection? – (water connections only)

A Utility Connection in the Rural Area is arranged thru the Whanganui District Council Water Team via the Rural Water Schemes.

The following Areas have a Rural Water Scheme:

- Mowhanau

What is the Process?

1. Home Owner to Obtain a Quote And Scheme Agreement from the Whanganui District Council Infrastructure Group — Water Team 2. The Home owner to Sign the Quote and the Scheme Agreement.

If Agreed return to:

The Whanganui District Council

C/O – Infrastructure Group – Water Team 3. Make Payment to Whanganui District Council

4. The Utility Connection is Installed
