Upgrade for Victoria Avenue/Ingestre Street traffic signals

Traffic signals at the intersection of Victoria Avenue and Ingestre Street are about to be upgraded.

Work is scheduled to begin in the first week of June, and is expected to take three weeks to complete.

The upgrade involves new underground ducts, cables and vehicle sensors as well as new traffic light poles and other above-ground equipment. There will also be minor changes to approach lanes to improve right-turn sight lines.

Separate streetlight poles close to the intersection will also be removed. Replacement streetlights will be mounted on the new traffic signal poles.

A traffic camera, to be monitored on a 24-hour basis by the New Zealand Transport Agency, will also be installed.

A temporary roundabout will be in place for the duration of the work.
